

CITY OF LONGBEACH

Background

Safe Long Beach is a Citywide violence prevention plan adopted by Long Beach City Council on May 13, 2014, which addresses a broad safety agenda aimed at reducing all forms of violence, including domestic abuse, child abuse, elder abuse, hate crimes, bullying, gang violence, and violent crime. The plan draws upon the City's many existing assets to target violence at its root and attain its goal of building a safer Long Beach by 2020. This document provides a summary of accomplishments since its inception.


